

Steps to follow when RAILPort fails to load due to cookies

- **For Chrome:**

1. Open Edge browser, select **Settings and more** ... > **Settings** ⚙ > **Cookies and site permissions**.
2. Under **Cookies and data stored**, select **Manage and delete cookies and site data** > **See all cookies and site data** and search for the site whose cookies you want to delete.
3. Select the down arrow ∨ to the right of the site whose cookies you want to delete and select **Delete** 🗑.

- **For Edge:**

1. Open Edge browser, select **Settings and more** ... > **Settings** ⚙ > **Cookies and site permissions**.
2. Under **Cookies and data stored**, select **Manage and delete cookies and site data** > **See all cookies and site data** and search for the site whose cookies you want to delete.
3. Select the down arrow ∨ to the right of the site whose cookies you want to delete and select **Delete** 🗑.

- **For Firefox:**

Clear cookies for the current website

To delete cookies and site data for a website you're currently visiting:

1. Click the padlock 🔒 at the left of the address bar.



2. Click **Clear Cookies and Site data**.
