





Setting Up Tiered Detention Profiles RAILTRAC® 2/8/2023


Once logged into RAILTRAC, click on the Reference tab. Next, select Consignee, then Detention Profiles, and select Tiered.




The Get Data for Tiered Detention Profile Maintenance box will appear. In this screen, select New.



User has the option to select the Info button or drop down to select the required Consignee Number. Start typing the Consignee Number, if known, to narrow down the choices.

Once the Consignee No. has been selected, use the Tab key to navigate to the remaining fields and enter in the Comm Class and Car Type. The user has the option to select the Info button or drop down to select the required Commodity Class, and drop down to select the required Car Type as well.


